## Gerrard Park Adult Softball Leagues General Sign Up Information

As you fill out the Columbus Softball Association (CSA) & Nebraska ASA Waiver/Release of Liability & Roster form, please keep the following in mind.

- ❑ Rosters must be postmarked by Friday, April 12th, 2019. Team rosters postmarked after April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 will be assessed a \$25 late fee which must be paid before the team roster is accepted. Absolutely NO late rosters will be accepted if not received by Sunday 7pm, April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 by calling the CSA President to set up a meeting at 402-942-4107. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- ❑ Remember to circle which league your team would like to play in on the top of the roster. **“D” Being the most competitive league in all divisions and “E-Rec” being the least competitive league offered.**
- ❑ Check, YES or NO, if your team plans on working the concession stand. **\$100 bond this season.**
- ❑ **An email address AND cell phone number of team contact is REQUIRED! This will be the route of communication for rain outs.**
- ❑ All equipment (i.e. bats and balls) must comply with the ASA Equipment rules for the 2019 season.
- ❑ **Regulation Bases will be played at a distance of 70’**
- ❑ **All Bats used must have an “ASA” certified sticker. If purchasing a new bat, it must have an “ASA 2013” certified sticker.**
- ❑ **Regulation Balls (Must be optic yellow ASA balls). Other information:**
  - **Men’s League and Coed League for Male batters must use a RED-stitch 12 inch ball with a Ball COR of .520 and a Ball Compression of 300.0 lbs**
  - **Coed League for Female batters must use an RED-stitch 12 inch ball with a Ball COR of .520 and a Ball Compression of 300.0 lbs.**
- ❑ ASA 2019 Rule Book is available on the ASA website at the following address and will also be included in your team packets: <http://www.ASASoftball.com>
- ❑ The rosters must be signed by all of the players listed on the form prior to the first game being played. If a player is added during the year, they must contact a League Board Member to have the original team roster signed prior to him or her playing their first game. Remember you can only be on ONE roster in men’s, women’s or coed divisions. A player can NOT play in more than one division in each league. NO EXCEPTIONS!! **Please see updated By-Laws about rosters and subs.**
- ❑ Umpire fees for the 2019 summer adult softball leagues, including all men’s and coed divisions, will remain at \$10 per team per game.
- ❑ Rescheduling of regular season games must be done prior to June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. No games can be rescheduled after June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. NO EXCEPTIONS! Each team will only be allowed to reschedule three (3) games prior to June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. (Rainouts may be rescheduled later than June 15, 2019.)
- ❑ The season is tentatively scheduled to start on Tuesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> 2019, depending on the number of registered teams. Leagues typically end the beginning of August.
- ❑ Emails & Text Messages will be sent to the team captains when the schedules and team information packets are ready. We will have them available at the **Mandatory Managers Mtg. Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 at Tournament Headquarters at 6:30 PM.**
- ❑ As always, we always appreciate volunteers to help out with the men’s and coed boards.
- ❑ We are currently updating the CSA By-Laws and they will be available on our website, along with the team packets.
